Revision and Quality of Book Support

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following feedback from teachers and reviewing the Quality of Book scores since returning to school in September, your child, has averaged a score of 2 or below in their QoB scores for this half term across their subjects. We believe that the quality of student's exercise books is a crucial aspect of a their academic development, and we are committed to providing the necessary support to ensure this issue is addressed.

Consequently, your child has been selected to attend a compulsory support session to help improve their Quality of books, and to give students more information on how to revise properly for their upcoming mocks and exams. The session has been specifically designed to address this concern – this is a supportive measure. This session will take place on Thursday 17th October, starting from 3:15 pm to 4:15 pm.

The objectives of study are:

- To provide a structured and supportive environment for students to improve their Quality of Book scores.
- To offer guidance and assistance on how to revise and use their exercise books.
- To help students develop effective time management and revision skills so that they can work independently at home.

We kindly request that your child brings their exercise books and any necessary materials to the study session. This will enable our teachers to offer targeted assistance and ensure that they make the most of their time during the sessions.



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We understand that every child's circumstances are unique, and our primary goal is to help your child succeed academically. Therefore, we strongly encourage your child to attend study sessions regularly. We believe that with their active participation and your continued support, they can overcome any challenges they may be facing in completing their homework assignments on time.
