Year 11 History trip: Thursday 8th December 2022

The History Department will be taking the History GCSE classes out on a Jack the Ripper walking tour and museum trip relating to their *Crime and Punishment through time: Whitechapel* topic to explore the Jack the Ripper murders and attempts to catch him.

This is a really important day of immersive learning for the pupils, in which they will gain a deeper understanding of Victorian London and the police failure in their desperate search for the notorious Jack the Ripper murderer. The cost of the trip will be £15.

These activities will take place during the school day on **Thursday the 8th of December**. Students will arrive at school at normal time and leave for the trips promptly after being registered. They will return to school within the normal school hours and will finish their school day at the usual time of 3.15pm. The total cost of this trip will be £15, which should be paid through ParentPay. If you are not registered for ParentPay please email support@allsaintscc.org.uk for instructions and a log in code. The students will make their way to and from both trips on the Circle Line, with a short walk either side. **Tube travel for the day will be covered by TfL.**

Students should be in their **school uniform and bring a packed lunch**. There will be a packed lunch provided by the school for children eligible for free school meals.
