I am delighted to report that our GCSE results were exceptional this year. 87% of our students passed both their GCSE English and Mathematics exams. 50% of all the examinations sat were graded as 7-9 (A*-A) – this high level of attainment puts All Saints amongst the highest performing schools in the country. We are delighted with how well our students have achieved and how hard they worked throughout the pandemic.
